## TASTING NOTES

### Merlot 2009

Appearance: Dense red with crimson hues and brilliant clarity.

Nose: Intense aromas of red and dark berry fruits, plum pudding overlaid with toasty vanilla oak.

Palate: Soft, medium bodied palate, with a fleshy sweet mid palate showing dark berry, mulberry and plum fruit flavours. Well integrated oak adds complexity in support of the fruit. Soft acid and fine tannins complete the structure which complement the delicious berry fruit finish of good length. An even balanced palate with lingering flavours makes this a very drinkable example of quality varietal Merlot.

Composition: 100% Merlot, Pemberton WA.

Alcohol: 13.6%.

Sweet/Dry: Dry.

Cellaring Potential: 5 - 8 years.
