TASTING NOTES

Sauvignon Blanc Semillon 2011

- Appearance: Light straw, lemon hues, brilliant clarity.
- Nose: Intense aromas of attractive sweet passionfruit, gooseberry and guava, grapefruit hints.
- Palate: Elegant palate shows great intensity of racy lime juice and passionfruit flavours at first with citrus grapefruit flavours emerging, framed by mineral zesty acidity which lingers on a clean and dry finish of good length.
- Composition 60% Sauvignon Blanc, 40% Semillon, Pemberton WA.
- Alcohol: 13.3%.
- Sweet/Dry: Dry.
- Cellaring Potential: 1 - 2 years, drink young.
